WHITE WINES

Bottle

1-Mas de Vigneron Sec, France

£16.50

A crisp, dry and refreshing white from Gascone in France that displays citrus characters.

2-Tierra Alta Sauvignon Blanc, Chile

£16.50

Tierra Alta Sauvignon Blanc from Chile's Central Valley is dry in taste with notes of yellow grapefruit.

3 -Ancorra Pinot Grigio , Italy

£17.95

A very popular and easy drinking style of dry white wine from Northern Italy that will not disappoint.

4 -Paarl Heights Chenin Blanc, South Africa

£18.50

Medium dry in taste with noticeable aromas of fresh granny smith apple with a touch of accia honey.

5 -Domaine de Vedilhan Viognier, France

£21.50

From the South of France, this medium in style white wine has notes of apricot, peach and touch of spice.

6 -Last Stand Chardonnay, Australia

£21.95

No oak is used in this excellent Aussie Chardonnay. It has a wonderful expression of exotic fruits such as pineapple.

7 -Moko Blanc Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand

£24.95

New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc at its very best - dry in mouth with lovely fruitful notes of gooseberry.

8 -La Colombe Chablis, France

£32.50

An excellent example of Chablis that is austere and has excellent mineral flavours that linger in the mouth.

9 -La Clochette Sancerre, France

£34.95

Simply stunning. This complex white wine is excellent to accompany fish and poultry dishes.

10 -Domaine Maltaverne Pouilly Fume, France

£38.50

A superb Pouilly Fume from a single domaine who are recognised as one of the best producers in the region.

ROSE

11 -Mirabello Pinot Grigio Rose, Italy

£17.95

Dry in taste yet with a touch of sweetness. This Fruitful rose reminds us of strawberry and cream on aroma.

12 -Domaine Pasquies Rose, France

£18.95

A great rose from the South of France. Totally dry in taste, a wine that will marry well with an assortment of foods.

RED WINES

13 -Mas de Vigneron Red, France

£16.50

House Red is made from Grenache and Syrah (aka Shiraz) grapes from the Rhone. Fruity and easy drinking.

14 -Tierra Alta Merlot, Chile

£16.50

A fantastic Merlot from Chile that is full - bodied yet fruitful with upfront characters of damson and plum.

15 -Bellefontaine Cabernet Sauvignon, France

£17.95

A wine to partner Beef, Lamb and Duck, this full - bodied red from the South of France has a lovely black currant note.

16 -Vega del Rayo Rioja, Spain

£18.50

Made from 100% Tempranillo grapes, this approachable style of Rioja can be enjoyed with or without food

17 -Chapelle du Marin Cotes du Rhone, France

£19.95

The wines of cotes du Rhone have good structure, an excellent level of red fruit characters and are superb value.

18 -False bay Pinotage, South Africa

£19.50

A big, full - bodied and powerful red wine from South Africa. A wine that is the perfect accompaniment to steak.

19 -Soldiers Block Shiraz, Australia

£21.50

This stunning Aussie Shiraz has upfront fruit notes of black currant alongside eucalyptus and a touch of pepper.

20 -Chianti Prunatelli, Italy

£23.95

Chianti at its very best. Prunatelli make wines that are medium - bodied and easy to drink in style.

21 -Nieto Senetiner Malbec Reserva, Argentina

£23.50

Great structure on this full - Bodied and 'masculine' red wine from Argentina's famous Medoza region.

22 -Reine de L'Arenite Fleurie, France

£30.95

An easy drinking style of red wine that has characteristics of cherry, red current and touch of strawberry.

23 -Fleurie, Henry Fessy 2009, France

£32.95

Raspberry fruit and an attractive purple red colour characterise this well made wine from the Gamay.

24 -Chateaufeuf du Pape Rouge, Maison Bouachon, France

£45.95

The robe is a deep, strong purple with amethyst shades. The nose is harmonious and complex.

CHAMPAGNE & SPARKLING

25 -Primo Prosecco, Italy

£22.50

This easy drinking Prosecco hails from one of the best winery areas of the Veneto region. Dry, crisp and refreshing.

26 -Mas Macia Brut Cava, Spain

£24.95

Mas Macia is a traditional Cava producer based outside of Barcelona, who make excellent affordable sparkling wine.

27 -Le Marquis de Marillac Champagne, France

£39.50

Produced by the famous house of DeVenoge in Epernay, our 'House Champagne' will not disappoint.

28 -Lallier Grand Cru Brut Champagne, France

£49.50

Lallier are a small family owned producer making luxury Champagne that are very highly sought after.

29 -Lallier Premier Cru Rose Champagne, France

£52.50

This excellent Rose Champagne is made mostly from the Pinot Noir grapes from renowned village of Ay.

30 -Moet et Chandon NV

£49.50

A third of Pino Noir, Pino Meunier and Chardonnay. Matured for 3 years in a bottle which helps give the wine its typical biscuity flavour.

31 -Bollinger Brut NV

£89.50

Bollinger comes from one of the top Champagne houses and is a delicious, dry full flavoured Champagne.

32 -Dom Perignon, France

£150.00

A fitting tribute to the genius of the Hautvillers monk who invented Champagne. A superb blend, using roughly equal proportions of Pino Noir and Chardonnay.
